**1.1 INDIVIDUAL CASE BASIS (ICB)**

A service arrangement in which the regulations, rates and charges are developed based on the specific circumstances of the customer's situation for a specific service application.

- A. Calls made to a telephone number with an NPA NXX that is associated with the rate center that is within the customer's local calling area are local calls regardless of the physical location of the called party.[1]

- [1] QCC is a reseller of local exchange service in Michigan. As such, the underlying carrier, AT&T not QCC, controls the rating of calls as local or toll. Because QCC is entirely dependent on AT&T for the rating of calls, QCC must utilize the same rating standard in its tariff as does AT&T. Based on the June 28, 2007, Compliance Filing of AT&T Communications Michigan, Inc. and TCG Detroit (Case No. U-15280), QCC understands that AT&T will apply the standard stated above. As such, QCC includes the above language in its tariff.
